SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

Aberfeldy 12 year old | Highland | £5.40

Nose: Creamy. Some sherried fruit with a trailing hint of smoke. Prune, custard and espresso bean.

Palate: Sweet, malty, a gentle peat but nonetheless the mouth feel is very clean. Vanilla, peaches in cream and subtle oak.

Finish: Ginger, malt, nutty nougat and maybe a little grapefruit zest.

Aberlour 12 year old | Speyside | £5.50

Nose: Rich fig, raisin and caramel. Soft, warm apples and a very light sprinkle of dark chocolate flakes.

Palate: Nutty, fruit and warming. More caramel, cinnamon, nutmeg and plenty of entertaining fruit notes.

Finish: Dark chocolate returns for the long finish.

Ardbeg 10 year old | Islay | £5.50

Nose: A ridge of vanilla leads to mountain of peat capped with citrus fruits and circled by clouds of sea spray.

Palate: Sweet vanilla counterbalanced with lemon and lime followed by that surging Ardbeg smoke.

Finish: Long and glorious; sea salted caramel and beach bonfire smoke.

Ardbeg Wee Beastie | Islay | £5.50

Nose: Sea spray and smoked malt. Hints of brown sugar, pear drops, a little vanilla and cooked apple.

Palate: Sweet and salty. Citrus oils and orchard fruits along with dark berry tartness and then some touches of clove and liquorice.

Finish: Exceptionally long and oily. Lemon sherbet and freshly cut peat.

Arran 10 year old | Highland Island | £5.40

Nose: Herbal, biscuity, hedgerow greenness and dried grass, like a long English summer's afternoon.

Palate: Tannins, a little sweet barley, vanilla.

Finish: Slightly bitter, maltiness.

The Balvenie Doublewood 12 year old | Speyside | £5.40

Nose: Gristy, supple nuttiness intertwined with spices. Honeyed sultanas and grapes.

Palate: Sweet. Quite malty, digestive biscuits, followed by green fruits and Cox's apple peel.

Finish: Spicy, slightly drying, still sweet.

The Balvenie 14 year old Caribbean Cask | Speyside | £8.25

Nose: The aroma is rich with notes of tropical fruits, namely passion fruit, and creamy toffee.

Palate: Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangoes with a hint of orange in the background.

Finish: The finish lingers with a vanilla focussed character.

Bruichladdich Classic Laddie | Islay | £5.40

Nose: Elegantly sweet with honey'd barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.

Palate: Red apples and white grapes, with touches of sweet cinnamon and brown sugar. Still softly coastal.

Finish: Mineral-rich malt, with toffee and more honey.

Bunnahabhain 12 year old | Islay | £5.50

Nose: Fresh, sweet. Seaweed, malt.

Palate: Soft, supple. Sherry, nutty. A little sweetness, malty, juicy sultana. Slightly coastal.

Finish: Sherried, mochaccino, herbal, balanced salty tang.

Clynelish 14 year old | Highland | £5.90

Nose: Zesty, mandarin, tangerine. Smoky.

Palate: Quite light, great clarity. Orange, soft acidity. Dry oak. Mixed fruits, vanilla, leather.

Finish: Quite long, bitter sweetness developing, spicy oak.

SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

Dalmore 12 year old | Highland | £6.00

Nose: Roasting beans, the oily nuttiness in a fine espresso, there are little notes of malt and cereal and butter from the pastry counter with rich orange from the fruit bowl on the counter.

Palate: Notes of Seville marmalade and triple sec with winter spices and fruitcake. Zesty cocoa and milk chocolate.

Finish: Medium, oranges.

Dalwhinnie 15 year old | Highland | £5.55

Nose: Aromatic, toffee, lush nectarine, custard. Floral, apple blossom, honeysuckle, pear, touch of smoke.

Palate: Malty. Walnuts steeped in honey. Gentle smoke with a touch of spice.

Finish: Long, malty, walnut, almond.

Glendronach 18 year old | Highland | £14.60

Nose: Sherry notes so thick you need a knife to cut them! There's a hint of old rum in there too, with pineapple and brown sugar in tow.

Palate: Christmas cake, rum again, chocolate-coated hazelnut, runny honey and a hint of Sauternes.

Finish: Fresh blackcurrant, blueberry pancakes with a generous helping of maple syrup.

Glenkinchie 12 year old | Lowland | £5.40

Nose: Sherry notes so thick you need a knife to cut them! There's a hint of old rum in there too, with pineapple and brown sugar in tow.

Palate: Christmas cake, rum again, chocolate-coated hazelnut, runny honey and a hint of Sauternes.

Finish: Fresh blackcurrant, blueberry pancakes with a generous helping of maple syrup.

Highland Park 12 year old | Highland Island | £5.60

Nose: Fresh floral notes abound the senses with a light grassiness. Notes of honey, citrus and sweetness.

Palate: Full with depth. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness.

Finish: Quite long with peppery spice and wood shavings.

Jura 10 year old | Highland Island | £5.50

Nose: Honeyed barley and peaches in syrup, with light wafts of fragrant wood smoke.

Palate: Oily and subtly spicy at first, before notes of earthy vanilla pod and chocolate-covered raisins develop.

Finish: Another touch of smoke rounds things off.

Kilchoman Machir Bay | Islay | £5.55

Nose: Citrus zests, crumbly vanilla biscuits and layers of elegant peat smoke.

Palate: A generous burst of tropical fruit and dried raisin opens the palate. Warming smoke continues to waft playfully.

Finish: Sherried fruits and sprinkle of cracked black pepper.

Kingsbarns Doocot | Lowland | £5.70

Nose: Sweet and floral, with apricot, foam banana sweets, digestive, and a little flinty element.

Palate: It's incredibly buttery and creamy, with heaps of tropical fruit, a hint of rhubarb, some aromatic spice, and citrus.

Finish: Long and delicately sweet, with a slightly sour raspberry note.

SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

Lagavulin 16 year old | Islay | £10.20

Nose: More like Lapsang Souchong tea than Lapsang Souchong! One of the smokiest noses from Islay. It's big, very, very concentrated, and redolent of iodine, sweet spices, good, mature Sherry and creamy vanilla. Stunning.

Palate: Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and Sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oak.

Finish: Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla.

Laphroaig 10 year old | Islay | £5.45

Nose: This opens on big peat notes. There are spices, and liquorice, as well as a big dose of salt. Sweetness amidst the classic medicinal and cool wood smoke we love.

Palate: Seaweed-led, with a hint of vanilla ice cream and TCP. The oak is big, and muscles its way into the fore as you hold this whisky over your tongue. An upsurge of spices develop – cardamom/black pepper/chilli.

Finish: Big and drying, as the savoury, tarry notes build up with an iodine complexity.

Ledaig 10 year old / Mull / £5.55

Nose: Quite light and well-balanced. There is a very soft peat with a gentle smoke. Notes of barley and malt extract, with walnut and pine oil and a hint of iodine, dried fruit and nuts.

Palate: Medium-bodied and quite rich. There are notes of spice and smoke gathering above the charred oak. The peat is quiet and dry with a touch of black pepper and earth.

Finish: Medium-length and slightly smoky with spice.

The Macallan 12 year old Double Cask | Speyside | £7.30

Nose: Classic dried fruit territory, if less intense than the Sherry Oak expression. Aromatic butterscotch too.

Palate: Creamy and honeyed with some thick-cut marmalade, cinnamon and warm pastries.

Finish: Fruity with vanilla and sultana.

Oban 14 year old | Highland | £7.15

Nose: Smoky, maritime nose with hints of sticking plasters and toffee brittle.

Palate: Smoky, creamy palate with notes of marmalade, toffee apples and pear cider. A development of cloves comes late palate.

Finish: A long, malty finish with toasty oak and spice.

Talisker 10 year old | Highland Island | £5.75

Nose: Fresh and fragrant. Through thick smoke come pear and apple peels, with pinches of salt and seaweed.

Palate: It's a bonfire of peat crackling with black pepper, with a touch of brine and dry barley. A delivery of orchard fruit provides a delicate and beautiful balance.

Finish: In a long finish, bonfire embers toast malt and crystallise a sugary underlay.

BLENDED SCOTCH MALT AND BLENDED SCOTCH WHISKY

Johnnie Walker Blue Label | Blended Scotch Whisky | £19.70

Nose: Fragrant with good body. Notes of oak, crisp spice, dried fruit, pastries. Berry fruits, aniseed, hints of cedar, a touch of spice and citrus.

Palate: Supple and balanced. Good toffee and hints of very wistful smoke. Chocolate, hints of grass and a good hit of malt.

Finish: Floral, oaky, good length, urged on by a plume of very well-kept, highland style smoke. Dried fruit, spice, honey.

Overall: One of the ultimate premium blends. Blue label is a legend in its own right and will continue to be.

Johnnie Walker Black Label | Blended Scotch Whisky | £4.70

Nose: Winter spice and treacle, hints of white pepper and a little citrus.

Palate: Rich and full with notes of wood smoke and dry spice, hints of barley and cereal with creamy toffee and a distinct herbal note.

Finish: Quite fruity and long with a note of sultanas and mixed peels.

Whisky Row Rich and Spicy | £4.70

Nose: Rather oaky, with caramelised nuts, cigar box and cinnamon stick.

Palate: Chocolate appears alongside more baking spices, leading into oaky vanilla and espresso.

Finish: A dry, spicy finish full of oak.

Whisky Row Smooth and sweet | £4.70

Nose: Pear skin and vanilla cream, leading into toasted spices and fudge.

Palate: Waxy peels and lemon curd alongside toasty oak and a drizzle of silky caramel.

Finish: Apple crumble and custard lingers.

Whisky row Smoke and Peat | £4.70

Nose: Fresh, toasted malt, with a pinch of tobacco, smoky cured meat and a burst of tropical fruit sweetness.

Palate: Dry peat smoke and wet pebble, leading into lemon zest and tinned pineapple alongside ashy notes.

Finish: Dried apricot and a smidge of burnt rubber linger with smoky barley.

The Famous Grouse | Blended Scotch Whisky | £4.10

Nose: Light, crisp. Cut flowers. Barley. Toffee sweetness.

Palate: Light and balanced. Spice, barley. Caramel, touch of smoke.

Finish: Touch of sweetness, caramel.



WORLD WHISKEY

Jameson | Ireland | £4.50

Nose: A full and floral nose leads with the smooth sweetness of marmalade and fudge before a hint of Madeira and a little cut grass note emerge.

Palate: Thick and of good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh and cooked with a little vanilla cream.

Finish: Medium-length with spice and honey.

Makers Mark | USA | £4.75

Nose: Fruity and rich. There are lovely notes of spiced honey and mixed peels, a little malmsey, hazelnut and a touch of cut fruit with toasty oak providing a backbone.

Palate: Rich and full. There are notes of rye and spice, barley malt, a little nut oil with butterscotch and vanilla.

Finish: Quite sweet with butterscotch and dry oak spice.

Bulleit Bourbon | USA | £4.80

Nose: Bright with orange zest, toasted oak and vanilla.

Palate: Further orange notes, followed by some warming winter spices and a hint of tobacco leaf.

Finish: Smooth and spicy.

Jack Daniels | USA | £4.50

Nose: Light with plenty of sweetness. There are hints of dry spice and oily nuts, a touch of smoke.

Palate: Quite smooth and soft with notes of banana milkshake, a mixed nut note, a touch of caramel with crème anglaise.

Finish: Sweet with a little cereal sweetness and toasty oak.

WHISK(E)Y LIQUEURS

Drambuie | Scotland | £4.60

A very famous whisky liqueur made with Scotch whisky, heather and herbs and spices. It is the oldest British whisky liqueur brand and its origins can be traced to a secret recipe created for Bonnie Prince Charlie in the 18th century. Drambuie offers flavours such as anise, nutmeg and saffron.

Glavya | Scotland | £4.45

Glavya is flavoured with honey, almonds, tangerines and spices. The name derives from the Gaelic for "very good"

Southern Comfort | U.S.A. | £4.40

It is made to an 1874 New Orleans recipe made with American whiskey, peaches, herbs and spices.
